## ***The Rega-institute: Building a L3+cluster on top of a labbuilding in construction***

By the end of September 2016 users of the new Rega-institute-building (13.000m<sup>2</sup>) will be moving in. This laboratory building will house researchers in microbiology, virology and medical chemistry. During the construction phase the decision was made to add an extra 600m<sup>2</sup> -L3+ cluster. This cluster will be in operation as of December 1<sup>st</sup> 2016. This one day workshop will be a unique opportunity to visit the new building and the L3+ facility.

We will announce inttime presenters and presentations from stakeholders with a light focus on the L3+cluster. These stakeholders will include users, projectmanagers, engineer, H&S, commissioner,... They will give an overview of the different specific aspects of this laboratoriumproject. Also a report from Egnaton-workinggroup 1 on this issue is on the programm. There will be a possibility to discuss and share experiences. Of course a guided tour is included.

### **How to get there?**

#### *From the airport*

There are trains to Leuven every twenty minutes.

#### *From the train station*

If you arrive by train at the train station of Leuven, take bus nr. 3 in the direction of the city center/university hospital Gasthuisberg, the bus stops in front of the Onderwijs en Navorsing 2 building and the entrance to the academic part of the Health Science Campus.

#### *By car*

Coming from Germany via Liège (Luik) over the E40, take the E314/A2 in Leuven direction Hasselt. Take the exit nr. 16 or 17 and follow the directions to the university hospital Gasthuisberg. Park in the public car par and walk to the building (10-15 minutes). The same exits on the E314/A2 can be reached coming from Germany through Aachen and The Netherlands through Eindhoven. Coming from The Netherlands over Antwerp, Mechelen and Brussels on the A16/E19, join the E40 direction Liège (Luik) in Brussels. Near Leuven, continue on the E314/A2 direction Hasselt and take the second exit right (nr. 16).
